LEVEL 2 OPENINGS ONLY WHEN NON VULN

2H = 4+ - 4+ in majors, weak

- Pass / 2S simple preference
- 2NT relay
 - 3C= 5-4 poor hand, then 3D asks for longer suit
 - 3D= 4-4 poor hand
 - 3H/3S= good hand (bid the longer suit)
 - 3NT= 4-4 good hand
 - 4C/4D= 5-5, splinter, good hand
 - 4H= 5-5, poor hand, pass or correct
- 3C/3D= to play
- 3H/3S= tempo raises

2S = 5-5 or 6-4 or (5-4)-3-1 in minors, weak

- 2NT relay
 - 3C= 5-5 poor hand
 - 3D= 5-5 max
 - 3H/3S= singl H/S, 5-4
 - 3NT= good hand, usually have an honour in majors
 - 4C/4D= 6-5 (bid the longer suit)
- 3C/3D= to play
- 3H/3S= 6+ suits, highly invitational
- 4C/4D= slamish (optional RKCB)

Escaping from NT (any range)

Opener		Resp	<i>Escaping from 1NT dbl</i>
1NT	DBL	pass	Believes that 1NTx is the best contract, nothing else to bid
		XX	We have at least 20 points in our side
		rest	Natural, 5+

After pass 1NT opener may bid a suit, usually 5card
